Traditionally, each orchestra presents its conductor with a token of its appreciation. Each student may bring \$2.⁰⁰ to Organizer for the purchase of this gift. Please bring \$2.00 cash to Thursday's sectionals. This is optional, but all are encouraged to participate.

Attendance

Students selected for All-Region Orchestra will be required to attend ALL rehearsals and the concert. Membership will be forfeited if a selected student fails to attend his/her rehearsals. Students may be disqualified for leaving the rehearsal site early.

Participation in TMEA Region organizations is one of the finest educational experiences available to middle and high school students; therefore, it is necessary that every student selected participate in all TMEA Region activities (rehearsals and concert) to the best of their abilities. Conflicts with other organizations, personal schedule conflicts, etc., will not constitute reasonable excuses for missing any activities in this Region. Exceptions: personal illness, hospitalization, and doctor's notes will be dealt with at the discretion of the Region Orchestra Chairman.

Tardy Policy: Any student that arrives late to the rehearsals will be automatically placed in last chair for the remainder of the rehearsals & concert (*No excuses will be allowed*). Please make travel time accordingly and arrive at least 15 minutes before tuning procedures.
